The Old Timers League Shot Their.22's on the 100 yard range.

What is the definition of an old timer? You need to be retired and have nothing pressing to do in the morning on Mondays. The Old Timers League shoots take place every Monday (weather permitting) for 5 Mondays then on the sixth Monday they go to lunch at the Old Country Buffet in Springfield. The Old Timers shoot a wide range of firearms (pistols, rifles, shot guns, air rifles etc.). They can be very competitive as everyone wants to show their proficiency with their favorite fire arm. There is plenty of one on one competition where one competitor would rather beat another competitor rather than win the match. If you fit this description please come out and join the fun.

The shoot that took place in January was .22's at 100 yards. There were several classes of .22s being used. Target With a Scope, Target Without a Scope, Sporter With a Scope, and Sporter Without a Scope. Anyone could shoot in any or all these classes. Each class will have its winner. But no one

shooter could win more than one class. The shoot took place every Monday starting at 10 AM sharp for 5 weeks.

It is not easy to shoot a 22 rifle at 100 yards especially in the winter with cold and windy conditions. Everyone did well and there were enough cold fingers to go around and a good time was had by all. January was a cold month and the shooters are a hearty lot however; there was one day that the event had to be cancelled due to inclement weather. There were three hearty souls who showed up ready to shoot on that day, and they did shoot even though it did not count in the standings. These three will remain nameless as this writer is not sure if they were just loyal shooters or just did not know enough to come in out of the weather.

There was a first time winner **Don Kaighn** in the Target With a Scope Class, Don shot 199/200/196/200/198 (993) only 7 points off a perfect score of 1000. **Outstanding and Well done Don.** The other winners are **Rudy Giarrocco** Target Without a Scope Class 196/196/188/197/196 (973), **Bud Feindt** Sporter With a Scope Class 195/199/198/199/200 (991) another great score just 9 points off a perfect score, and **Carl Cervino** Sporter Without a Scope Class 168/173/181/172/175 (869). Again Carl has won against his arch rival Bob Britton. Come on Bob we know one of these times you can take Carl. I am not sure how many times Bud has won at these shoots I think he shot in the class he did so he would not have to face Don and have to pay for his own lunch. Listed below are all the scores.
