DCF&S Member, Glenn Talley wins 2011 IBO Championship

Every year archery shooters from around the world compete in their local qualifier competition shoots in order to be able to attend the World Championship competition. Usually this is held at a large venue in order for the event to handle the large amount of competitors. Men, women and youth shooters all compete in separate classes according to their gender and their choice of equipment.

This years IBO World Championship was held at the Holiday Valley resort in Ellicottville New York. Competitors from all across the United States, Canada, Europe and Australia were in attendance for the three days of competition. Two DCF&S members Glenn Talley and Mike Wiciak were there to show the IBO who they were. By the end of the second day of shooting, Glenn, who was shooting in the MSR class (Men's Senior Class" was informed that he was tied for first place. In order to break a tie the shooters must shoot one more target with one arrow, highest scoring ring wins. So, Saturday morning, Glenn with bow in hand was off to the mountain. Glenn's competition was Patrick Adams, from Tipp City Ohio. Glenn wins the toss of the coin to see who will shoot first. He graciously lets Patrick shoot first. For anyone that has shot in any type of competition, you know that right now the tension is extremely high. Not because you're



shooting against someone one to one, but because at this event there is usually a ton of people there watching you shoot this one arrow.

Calm nerves, knowing your equipment and a good sense of judging distance are key in this sport. Patrick stepped up to the line and fumbled with finding his release. With arrow nocked and at full draw, Patrick released his arrow, which landed in the 8 ring. Now it was Glenn's turn. With confidence Glenn stepped to the line and nocked his arrow. When Glenn released his arrow the crowd cheered with excitement! Glenn actually wasn't sure of where the arrow had landed but knew from the crowd that he had just won. With his arrow in the 11 ring, Glenn Talley was a new IBO Champion! His final score was 499 with 19.1 X's. Congratulations Glenn! We knew you could do it and we're all proud to say you're a member of Delaware County Field & Stream.

Both Glenn and Mike are truly dedicated to their sport of Archery. Both are to be congratulated in their efforts and if you should see them at the club or on the Archery Range make sure you congratulate them.
